General Circular Number 09 of 2020 (GC 09/2020)

Objectives of this General Circular:

In view of current circumstances where patients are prohibited to visit hospitals (except for emergencies), and the possible need for patient requiring consultations, five new DSL codes will be introduced to cater for teleconsultation services with effect from 5 April 2020:

DSL Code	Description
41	Teleconsultation – GP
42	Teleconsultation – Specialist
43	Teleconsultation – Consultant
44	Teleconsultation – Allied Health
45	Teleconsultation – Psychotherapy (Psychologist)

A teleconsultation is define as a healthcare consultation carried out remotely using audio/visual telecommunications between clinical professionals and patient for various clinical specialties. It does not include nursing consultations. Please note that all categories of GPs, specialists and consultants conducting teleconsultations will be covered in the respective codes.

All service providers, insurers and TPAs are encouraged to begin discussions on pricing immediately.
